Catholic Responses to Assassination of Charlie Kirk As we grieve the brutal murder of Charlie Kirk, founder of Turning Point USA, we recall that the center of his life was not politics, but his faith in Jesus Christ, which he unabashedly proclaimed. He was also a model of civil discourse, combining conviction with a readiness to listen to others and engage in respectful debate with those who opposed him. Father Mike Schmitz, Word on Fire's Evangelization and Culture Editor-in-Chief Tod Worner, Bishop Robert Barron and the founder of Real Life Catholic, Chris Stefanick have shared passionate reflections on Charlie's life, his faith in Jesus Christ and being an, "apostle of civil discourse." Candles will be lit and carried forward by family members, just before the entrance procession, and placed before the image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.
