There are a limited number of receivers available for use during Mass or, if you already have a hearing aid that uses Bluetooth, you can download an app that will work using your Smartphone.

Which hearing assistance unit should I use?

My hearing aid uses T-coil

Ask an usher for the PPA-R38 receiver w/neckloop.
Enable "T-coil" on your hearing aid



Set your receiver volume to 15 as a starting point and then adjust as needed.

My hearing aid uses Bluetooth

At home, using your Smartphone or Tablet, download the following app to your phone or Tablet:
Williams Sound WaveCAST



When you come to Mass, on your Smartphone (or Tablet), connect to Sacred Heart's intranet:
Wifi SSID: SH-SoundSystem
Password: 12345678

(You are not connecting to the internet but to Sacred Heart's internal network for hearing assistance; therefore you may see the message 'no internet'. This is normal.)

After connection, open the WaveCast app which you previously downloaded at home, and find "SacredHeartSound" to listen

Use your hearing aid app to adjust sound as needed.

I do not have a hearing aid

Ask an usher for the PPA-R38 receiver w/headphone. You can also bring your own headphone from home. The headphone will need a 3.5mm (1/8") plug.



Set your receiver volume to 15 as a starting point and then adjust as needed.
