CONCERNS OF PARISHIONERS

Father is working with the wireless microphone to try improving the quality so he can be heard. It was discussed consulting with someone with sound system knowledge to see what can be done.

Right now with the number of parishioners attending Mass, Father feels there is not a need for another individual to distribute Holy Communion.

It was mentioned a parish member was surprised at a charge received from an event at church. Question asked is if there is a list for funerals and weddings. There is a concern about the first Saturday devotion at the convent due to the size of the room, if there will be ample seating. Father will evaluate Mass attendance on October 2nd.
