Meeting was called to order

Opening Prayer was said by Debbie Adamski, President, PCCW

Reports:

1. Reading & approval of May 8, 2023 meeting minutes read by Debbie Adamski – Chris Zinda  
    Germaine Zoromski moved for approval of the minutes. Seconded by Betty Kowalski.  
    Motion passed unanimously by voice vote

2. Financial Report presented by – Judy Wroblewski

    St. Ambrose PCCW General Fund - \$44,176.22 (3.20% interest rate)  
    St. Ambrose Seminarian Fund - \$2,192.99  
    St. Ambrose Cookbook Fund - \$12,877.75  
    Active checking account balance - \$9,437.51

    Sue Wanta moved for approval of the financial report. Seconded by Ruth Printz. Motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

3. Cookbook Account reported by – Betty Kowalski  
    Dorothy Burant moved for approval of the cookbook account report. Seconded by Ann Omernik. Motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

4. Communications

    A thank you card was read from the Family of Esther Hintz.

Old Business:

1. The diapers and wipes were split in thirds. One third going to each:
  - First Choice Pregnancy Resource Center
  - Operation Bootstrap
  - Rosholt Food Pantry

    All three facilities were very grateful and surprised to receive them.

2. Soup Sale – It was suggested the profits go toward painting of the stations, which will cost about \$40,000 and Father gave approval to be finalized when the date is set. October? -depending if the kitchen/hall will be available.

Soup sale will be held on November 11, 2023. Father will be asked to have Saturday morning mass at St. Mary's. Dorothy Burant moved that 50% of all funds raised by the PCCW be assigned to the paving of the stations. Ruth Printz seconded. Motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

#### New Business:

1. Funeral Meals -- There will not be any funeral luncheons during the renovation of the church.

2. The kitchen sink was leaking after the picnic and water was coming into the kitchen from under the cabinets, so a plumber was called in, and the repairs were made. The invoice for the repairs is \$1,778.60.

Sue Wanta moved for approval to pay the invoice of \$1,778.60 for the sink repair. Seconded by Audrey Gagas. Motion passed unanimously by voice vote

3. The senior bingo for this year was approved by Father. The tables would be set up after Thursday morning Mass and then taken down the same day after bingo.

Betty Ostrowski moved for \$30.00 a month be given for Senior Bingo (a \$60.00 check every 2 months will be written during the season). Germaine Zoromski seconded. Motion passed unanimously by voice vote. Getting help to move the tables would be appreciated.

4. Steak Night is November 4. PCCW will oversee the salads and desserts. A sign-up sheet will be passed around.

The sign-up sheet was passed with a number of ladies volunteering. Thank you ladies. An announcement will be placed in the bulletin for workers as well.

5. Bingo is scheduled in March. Will there be food? Any other activities? (i.e. raffle, cherry tree, etc.) Supplies? (i.e. daubers, special game sheets, etc.)

Bingo date is March 3, 2024. Food will be available, desert table, popcorn, pop and water. There will be a 50/50 and Audrey Gagas will be organizing the Cherry Tree.

6. Mass for the 60+ members be 4:00pm Saturday, October 21, 2023.

Debbie shared information with the members on how the PCCW fundraising money has been spent in the last two years. She would like to share this with

the parish members through the bulletin and at mass when the PCCW donation envelope becomes available.
