Call to Order

4. Communications

They helped at the party walking around the tables filling beverages, busing the tables, scraping dishes, wiping dishes, etc. They each worked about 2 ½ hours. They are trying to raise money to travel to the “Walk for Life” in Washington DC. We would like to pay them for their help. Last year we paid \$100 for labor on the bill and gave a \$200 tip.

Delores Lepak moved a payment of \$300.00 be made to the students. Seconded by Germaine Zoromski. Motion was amended to be \$400.00 (\$100.00 per student).

Amended motion was approved by Delores Lepak. Germaine Zoromski also approved the amendment. Amendment passed unanimously by voice vote.

New Business:

1. Ponczkas will be made the weekend of February 10-11. The 4:00pm Saturday Mass will be at St. Mary's in Custer. Last year we charged \$9 for unfilled ponczkas, \$9.50 for filled ponczkas, and \$4.50 for peanut squares. St. Mary-Torun is charging \$11.50 for unfilled and \$12 for filled.

- Price for ponczkas and peanut squares? \$11.50/\$12.00 Motion made by Ann Omernik to approve the price. Seconded by Germaine Zoromski. Motion passed unanimously by voice vote. The batch will be reduced to 25 for the ponczkas and remain the same as last year for the peanut squares.

- Will people be called to work? Karen Klesmith and Arleen Gross will contact the workers.
- Bulletin announcement for workers? Debbie Adamski will take care of the announcement.
- Announcement for ponczka sale in other parishes bulletins? Members decided that all parishes should be contacted.
- Selling times for Saturday and Sunday? Sale will be a first come – first serve until all are sold. Sale will be Saturday, February 10th from 2:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. Sunday, February 11th before and after mass. Germaine Zoromski volunteered to sell ponczkas and peanut squares at the handicapped entrance. Rest of sale will take place in the basement.

2. Susanna said Cherise needs a new vacuum for the church. Rick fixed the vacuum a couple times, and it can no longer be fixed. She has been carrying the school vacuum from the school to the church and back. She had a Shark vacuum in the church and would like the replacement to be a lightweight Shark because she has to carry it up to the choir loft and use it on the steps. The cost would be \$400-\$500.

Motion made by Germaine Zoromski to purchase a Shark vacuum with a cost between \$400.00 - \$500.00. Seconded by Kathy Groshek. Motion passed unanimously by voice vote.
